Lesson One

The Residence of the Divine Spirit and the Key to the Indwelling Spirit

I. The two spirits mentioned in the New Testament:

- A. John 3:6 "...that which is born of the Spirit is spirit."
- B. John 4:24 "God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truthfulness."
- C. Rom. 8:16 "The Spirit Himself witnesses with our spirit that we are children of God."

II. The human spirit being the residence of the Holy Spirit—Rom. 8:9-10.

III. The two spirits are mingled together to become one spirit—Gal. 5:16; 1 Cor. 6:17.

Gal. 5:16 But I say, Walk by the Spirit and you shall by no means fulfill the lust of the flesh.
1Cor. 6:17 But he who is joined to the Lord is one spirit.

IV. The locating of the divine Spirit in our human spirit—2 Tim. 4:22.

2 Tim. 4:22 The Lord be with your spirit. Grace be with you.

V. The need of dividing the soul from the human spirit—Heb. 4:12:

Heb. 4:12 For the word of God is living and operative and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing even to the dividing of soul and spirit and of joints and marrow, and able to discern the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

- A. The type of the temple with the outer court, Holy Place and Holy of Holies— cf. 1 Cor. 3:16; Heb. 10:19.
- B. The type of the children of Israel going out of Egypt, through the wilderness, to enter into the good land—Heb. 4:9, 11.

VI. The most vital matter being to know our spirit and to deny our soul— Mal. 2:15b, 16b; Matt. 16:24-25.

VII. The human spirit being the key:

- A. Our human spirit is the dwelling place of the Holy Spirit—2 Tim. 4:22.
- B. Our human spirit is one with the wonderful Holy Spirit—1 Cor. 6:17.

VIII. Our need is to exercise our spirit to contact the living Christ and fellowship with Him Who is indwelling our spirit—John 4:24.
